<u>Research Program</u> (<u>All Grades)</u>

Summer Programs

<u>Research Internship Program</u> (<u>Gr. 8 - 12)</u>

Gain **real-world research experience** by analyzing and exploring global emerging issues. Learn **data analysis**, and develop **problem-solving skills** through mentor's research/funding projects in small groups.

20 hours in 4-6 weeks, excluding individual/group research times

<u>IVY Intensive/Interactive</u> <u>Program (Gr. 7 - 12)</u>

Interact with top faculty at MIT, Harvard, Stanford, & UC Berkeley in various subjects & build critical thinking through hands-on project, and explore various fields to develop & deepen students' perspective & interests.

20 hours per week over 4-6 weeks

<u>Critical Thinking Program</u> <u>via Reading & Writing</u>

Engage in **critical thinking** through **literary** analysis with deep discussions in online group sessions, and receive individual feedback each week. This will empower students to build effective verbal & written communication early on.

90 mins per Weekly Session (excludes feedback on prompt responses)
